Class Representatives Role

The main objective of the Class Representative position is to promote, foster and encourage positive collaboration between FREDs and the parents of each class.

Class Representatives play a key role in the smooth running of FREDs activities. Their role is specifically to cascade information about FREDs to and from parents and, where appropriate, drum up interest in FREDs events and volunteer as and when they can.

It is important for individual parents to communicate directly with the St Edward’s Leadership Team, Management or Class Teachers. Therefore, Class Representatives are politely requested not to act as a channel of communication on behalf of a parent or on behalf of a group of parents with the Leadership Team, Management or Class Teacher, unless the communication specifically relates to a FREDs activity.

Duties include:

- Attend FREDs meetings;
- Cascade FREDs information to Class Parents;
- Collate any feedback about FREDs from parents and share with the FREDs committee;
- Encourage participation from Class Parents in events initiated and led by FREDs.
