EVENTS

JP recapped the events that FREDs were able to carry out over the last year (Xmas Cards, Summer Fete and Online Uniform Shop) and what went well which each one.

Considering the fact that FREDs were limited in what was possible the Summer Fete was an amazing success.

In the first term FREDs financed the Walk with Hawks event which was a huge success and the children at St Edward's loved it.

A stronger relationship has been built with the school through communications and events, and JP again reiterated FREDs thanks to the school for their support.

Finances

AB provided a review on the finances for 20/21 highlighting what monies were made and how it has been spent.

Action: A poster to be created advertising what who FREDs are and what the funds raised have been used for over the past couple of years (SeM)

During the summer holidays in 2020 a play area was purchased for the EYFS area.

£840 went on the EYFS play area, £321 on the Walk with Hawks and £350 on the Xmas gift for the children. Some of the big fundraising events were cancelled (Wonder Woman Sale and Super Man Sale), but the Summer Fete brought in a profit of £890 and the Xmas cards made £154.

School uniform online sales has been a big success, with sales of almost £600 so far, net of refunds and fees.

ACTION: Parents to continue to donate uniform that they no longer need. Class Reps to cascade a request (at the end of each half term?). TR to create a 1 pager with guidance on what should / shouldn't be donated

Funds available at end of 2020-2021 year approx. £787 (after £350 committed to Walks with Hawks and £1000 committed to Guinness World Records).
