It has been brilliant to see the children, their families and the

Our fundraising events have included refreshments at House Rugby and Cricket, the Wonder Woman and Superman sales, Xmas4Schools card and gift design purchases, tickets for the last Reading FC last home game of the season, and the wonderful Summer Fete.

FREDs arranged a Welcome Back BBQ and a Fair to celebrate the Coronation of King Charles. We also supported the Climate Summit, not only giving every pupil a badge, but creating our own Climate Pledge too that we are applying to our events.

Thanks to your support, we have been able to order the **defibrillator** for the school and our attention now turns to the replacement of the fort (although this will be a longer term project as the costs are substantial).

Our Climate Pledge: **We aim to produce zero landfill waste in the** delivery of all FREDs activities. In 2022/23 we:

- Reduced the production of documents, e.g. posters
- Encouraged people to bring own bags for WW and SM sales
- Purchased sustainable material products/things that could be recycled - e.g. napkins, plates, cups, paper bags
- Reduce food waste by asking for pre-orders of food
- Had recycling stations at events

TREASURER'S REPORT

The aim of FREDs treasury is to ensure accounts accuracy and support the smooth running of FREDs operations. It is also to keep an eye on the day to day balances of the accounts so that approvals for spend can be approved swiftly and as appropriate within the FREDs ethos.

Following a quieter couple of years, 2022/23 has been a much busier year for FREDs, with the return of some old favourites and some brand new events

Income

- Once again Uniform Sales were the principal source of funding raised throughout the year with a fantastic £769.12 achieved; many thanks to all of you who have either donated items or have purchased from the shop.
- The **Summer Fete** made a very welcome return and generated funding of £422.25 net of expenses.
- Other fund raising was achieved through the annual Wonder
 Woman and Superman Sales, the Xmas4Schools Christmas
 Card/Gift designing event, ticket sales for a RFC match and refreshment sales at a number of the school's sporting events.
- The fund raising total for the year was £2,158.81

Expenditure

- Our biggest purchase this year was the **defibrillator** for the school at £1,128.00
- Other material purchases were the Climate Summit badges, purchases for the Welcome Back BBQ,
 Coronation Party and Summer Fete events
- A donation to the Parkinson's charity, in memory of Mrs Daley-Franks' husband, and some gift & sundry items purchases made in advance for 2023/24.
- In total our purchases for the year came to £2,160.41

Together these transactions have reduced our funds available balance by £1.60 with details set out in the table below.
