For those younger pupils, that are under eight years of age, the club runs an "All Stars" training package for those that are very new to the game. This scheme operates on Saturday morning and parents can sign their child up for this by going on the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB)'s All Stars website where SUCC is a registered participant.
